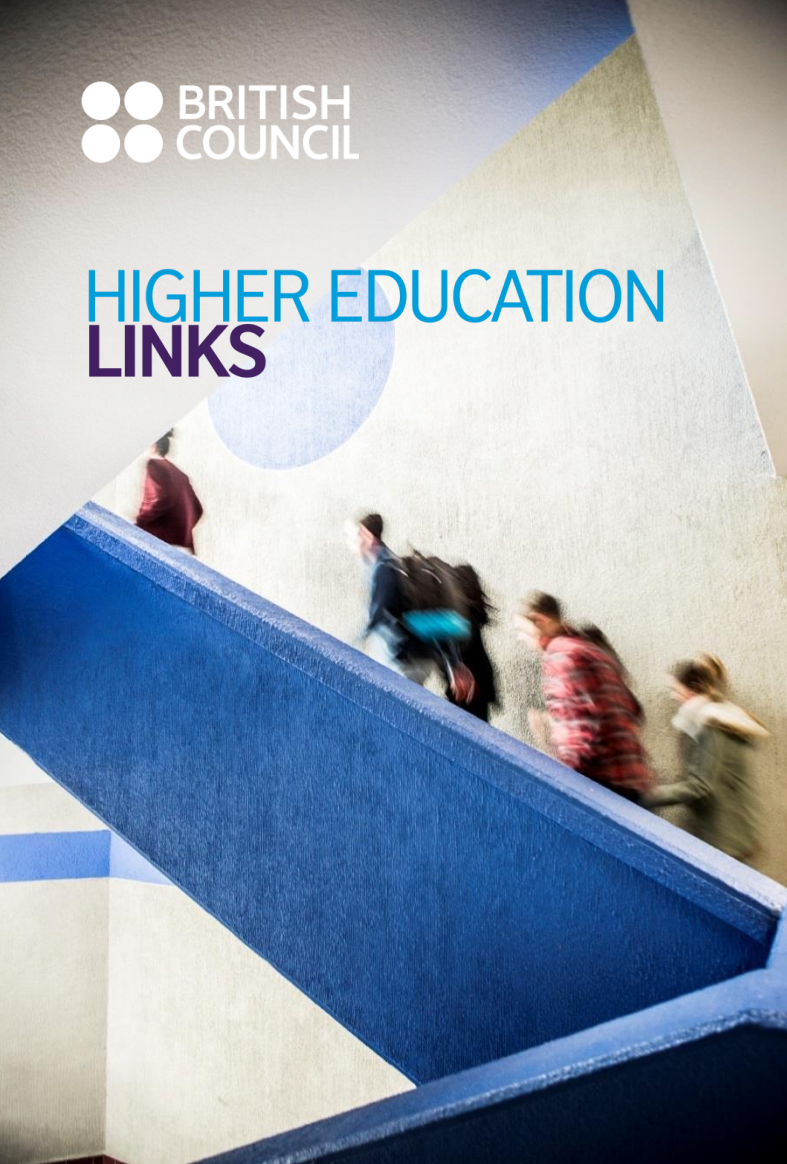


HIGHER EDUCATION LINKS



Higher Education Links is a British Council programme to provide small scale seed funding for high quality bi-national collaborations (Argentina – UK) aimed to improve the role that Argentine Higher Education Institutions play on the regional development agenda with a global focus.

Selected proposals through this open call must help to strengthen the institutional links between academia, government and the private sector in Argentina.

Priority areas:

- Student Employability and Competitiveness.
- Research and Development.
- Social Innovation and Inclusion.

Objectives:

- Establish links or significantly develop existing links between Argentine Higher Education Institutions and UK Institutions.
- Contribute to capacity building of programme participants and stakeholders.
- Support the development of bilateral projects aimed to achieve a specific regional development goal in Argentina.
- Promote the inclusion of Higher Education Institutions in a wider regional development agenda.

Eligibility:

Proposals must include one applicant from the UK and one applicant from Argentina.

Argentine applicants must be based at a not-for-profit Higher Education Institution with a record as a regional development promoter agent, including Universities and Research Centres.

UK applicants must be based at a not-for-profit Institution with a record as an international development promoter agent, including Universities, Research Centres, Public Offices and NGOs.

Project:

- ✓ A 3 to 5 day bi-national workshop to be carried out in Argentina which must include at least 2 UK mentoring sessions.
- ✓ A proposal for Argentine Higher Education Institutions to expand their role as a platform for regional development in a global context.
